The Holberg Prize is awarded to a scholar who has made outstanding contributions to research in the humanities, social sciences, law or theology. The Prize is worth NOK 6 million (approx. EUR 590,000 / USD 700,000). Academics holding positions at universities, academies or other research institutions are entitled to nominate candidates.
